HOOFED ANIMAL: Any hoofed animal, including any cattle, sheep, **goat**, horse or mule.

HOOFED PET: Any **goat** weighing less than one hundred (100) pounds at maturity.

G. Hoofed pets are limited to two (2) per household or dwelling. The maximum number of dogs, cats and hoofed pets in any household or dwelling shall not exceed four (4) total animals. (1968 Code §11-113; Ord. 74-114; 1980 Code; Ord. 87-36; Ord. 91-32; Ord. 01-42; Ord. 03-31; Ord. 03-121; Ord. 07-134; Ord. 14-28)

B. Hoofed Pets: It shall be unlawful for any person to keep any:

1. Unaltered male hoofed pets over the age of two (2) months.
2. Hoofed pet with horns or horn buds over the age of two (2) months.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to own or keep any pet or hoofed animal which by any unreasonably loud and persistent barking, howling, baying, yelping, crowing, crying or other utterance disturbs the peace and quiet of the neighborhood.

6.8.108: REGISTRATION OF **HOOFED PETS:**

The owner or keeper of a **hoofed** pet must register the **hoofed** pet with the City's animal control services provider immediately after acquiring the animal. The fee for the required **hoofed** pet registration shall be twelve dollars (\$12.00). (Ord. 14-28)

6.9.104: REQUIREMENTS FOR KEEPING **HOOFED ANIMALS; EXCEPTION:**

The provisions of this article shall not be applicable to any person engaged in operating a packinghouse or slaughterhouse governed by Colorado Department of Agriculture regulations, nor to any person keeping **hoofed** animals for a temporary period of time, not to exceed seventy two (72) hours, in connection with the operation of that type of business. (1968 Code §11-143.5; Ord. 74-59; 1980 Code; Ord. 91-32; Ord. 01-42)
